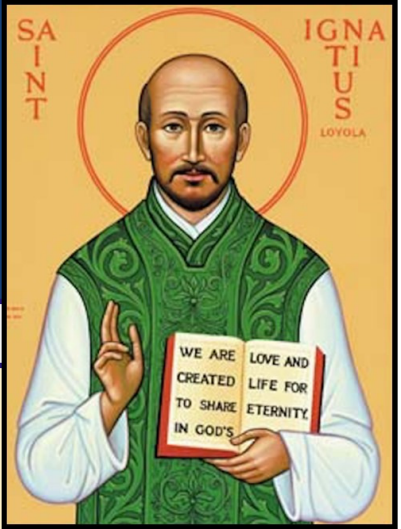

A Message from the Pastor

Dora Bittau entitles her fourth panel, from the life of St. Ignatius, *Confirmed in Mission at LaStorta*. Ignatius was traveling to Rome with Peter Faber and James Lainez. Ignatius had been praying for two things. He asked God to confirm what he and his companions were doing in going to Rome and placing themselves at the disposal of the Pope. He also was asking Mary, the Mother of God, to “place me with your Son.” Both prayers would be answered at LaStorta.

At a small chapel outside of Rome, Ignatius and Faber and Lainez stopped to pray. There St. Ignatius was granted another mystical vision. He heard God the Father tell him, “I will be favorable to you in Rome.” He also saw the Father ask Christ to take Ignatius as a companion in mission. The Christ that Ignatius saw was the risen Lord but he was carrying his cross. As Jesuit David Fleming pointed out, “This is the challenge that Ignatius saw would remain with the Society of Jesus and with all who follow an Ignatian spirituality.” We are companions of “the risen Christ who continues to carry the cross in all aspects of our life—our personal life, in our family and community life, and especially in our Ignatian mission.”

Pastor's Message continued from page one:

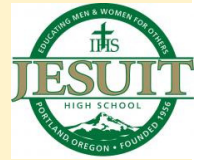
St. Ignatius' great desire was that he and his friends could be *companions of Jesus*. When he presented himself and his companions to be approved as an Order, St. Ignatius proposed the name *Companions of Jesus*. Many in Rome were scandalized and upset at the arrogance of this Spanish Basque. This was the first proposed religious order to take the name of Jesus. And yet it came directly from that vision at LaStorta where the Father placed Ignatius with his Son.

But St. Ignatius and his early followers were not the only *companions of Jesus*. The Jesuit priests and brothers who have built on the foundation that Ignatius and his first followers established are also *companions of Jesus*. Those of you who teach or work in a Jesuit School are *companions of Jesus*. Those of you who share your time and your talent and your treasure here at St. Ignatius Parish are *companions of Jesus*. Those of you who love and support children or grandchildren with special needs are *companions of Jesus*. Those of you who care for a seriously ill spouse or for a beloved family member or loved one in *Hospice* are *companions of Jesus*. Those of you who see the suffering all around you and reach out in any small way to alleviate their suffering are *companions of Jesus*.



The gift of the Vision of LaStorta is not just St. Ignatius' gift and confirmation but ours as well. May this knowledge both encourage us and strengthen us to be true to the name we have been given—*companions of Jesus*—as we grow in *awareness* of blessings received, *gratitude* for all these blessings in life, and *generosity* in sharing them with the suffering in our parish, our city, our country and our world.
