A Message from the Pastor

I will come to you in the silence.
I will lift you from all your fear.
You will hear my voice.
I claim you as my choice.
Be still, and know I am near.

David Haas, in his song *You Are Mine*, writes:

On this 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus addresses one of the great spiritual illnesses of our time and offers the antidote. The illness is fear. The antidote is to experience and trust in God's love.

I know people whose lives and life-choices revolve around fear. It could be the fear of the unknown; the fear of the loss of oneself; the fear of pain; the fear of rejection; the fear of humiliation; the fear of disappointment; the fear of failure; the fear of falling in love; or the fear of death. Fear can take so many shapes—fear of not being a good enough mother or father; fear of not being a good enough son or daughter; fear of not being a good enough or pastorally sensitive enough priest or pastor; fear of being presumptuous or ungrateful; fear of backing the wrong horse or having chosen the wrong path to travel down in life.

Here's a little secret. Even Popes are not exempt from fear. Pope St. John XXIII left us a great example of how to deal with fear. The story is told in his biography that the last thing he prayed before going to bed was: "Thank God it's Your Church!"

Good Pope John could have easily fallen victim to the fear that he was not a good enough or holy enough Pope. But he realized that God's grace is at work even in the most imperfect of people. God would do the heavy lifting. He could always count on that—and so can we!

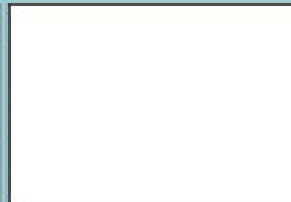
